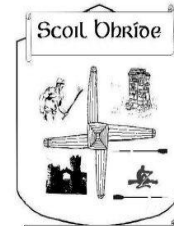

It is a sustainable method to grow food and one which we hope will provide both food and flowers for the school. In the coming week we hope to paint our wonderful beds a beautiful yellow colour. In time we also hope to have the veg beds painted. Have you seen all of the veg which, thanks to the great weather, has burst out of the ground lately? We would also like to thank Margaret Small, granny to Ciara, Aoife and Conor Gannon, who donated two crates of bluebells to the school recently. They have been planted under the trees and we can't wait to see them next spring.
