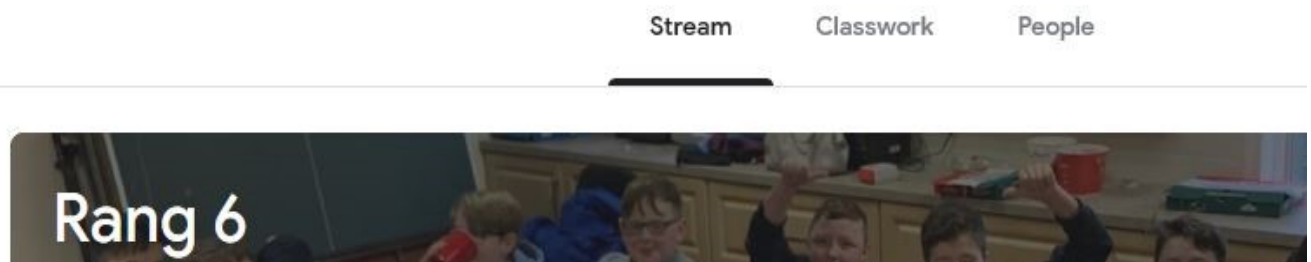

Submitting work for correction - using google doc or slides

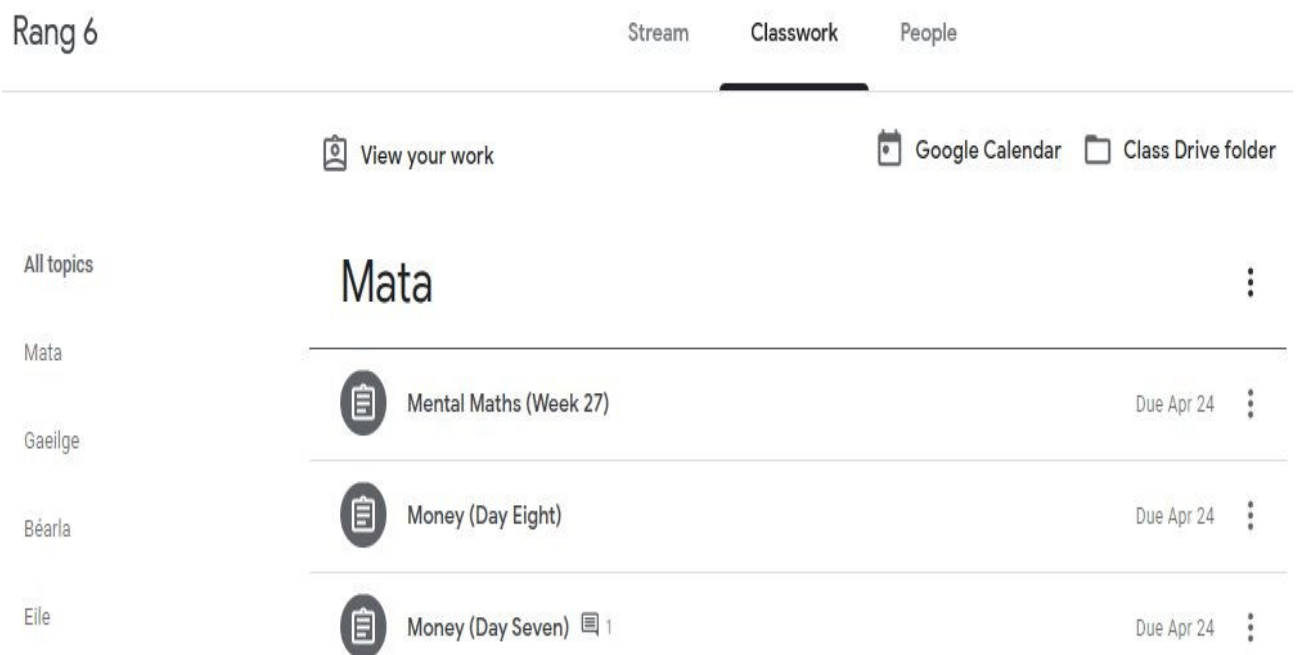


This is the homepage of Rang 6. All of the classes look the same. There are three tabs at the top of the page **Stream** **Classwork** **People**

I can also create a document - a google doc/slide. This means I can type my answer straight away onto the doc and save it.

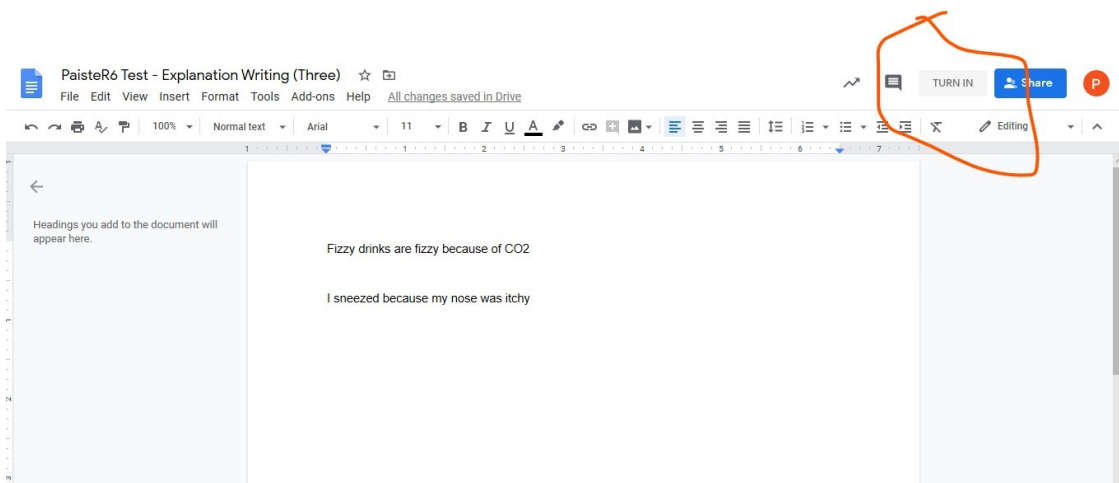
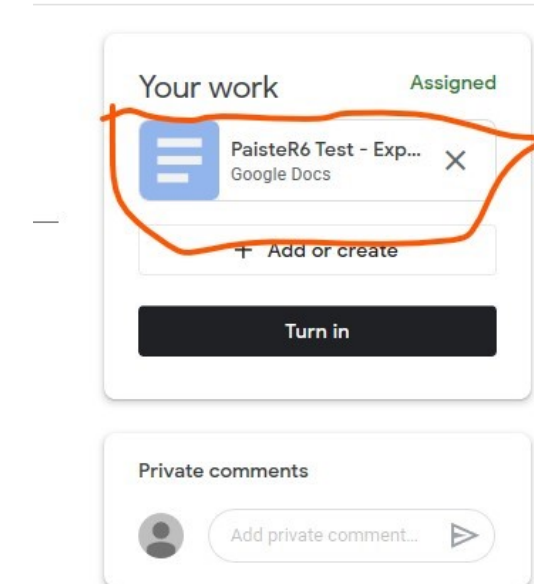
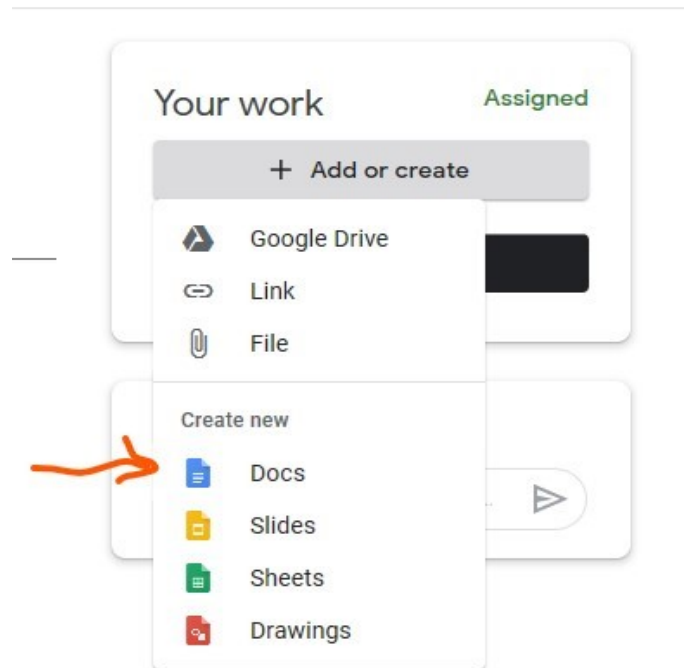
I want to create a doc, so I click on that. **Only you and your teacher can see and comment on your work.**

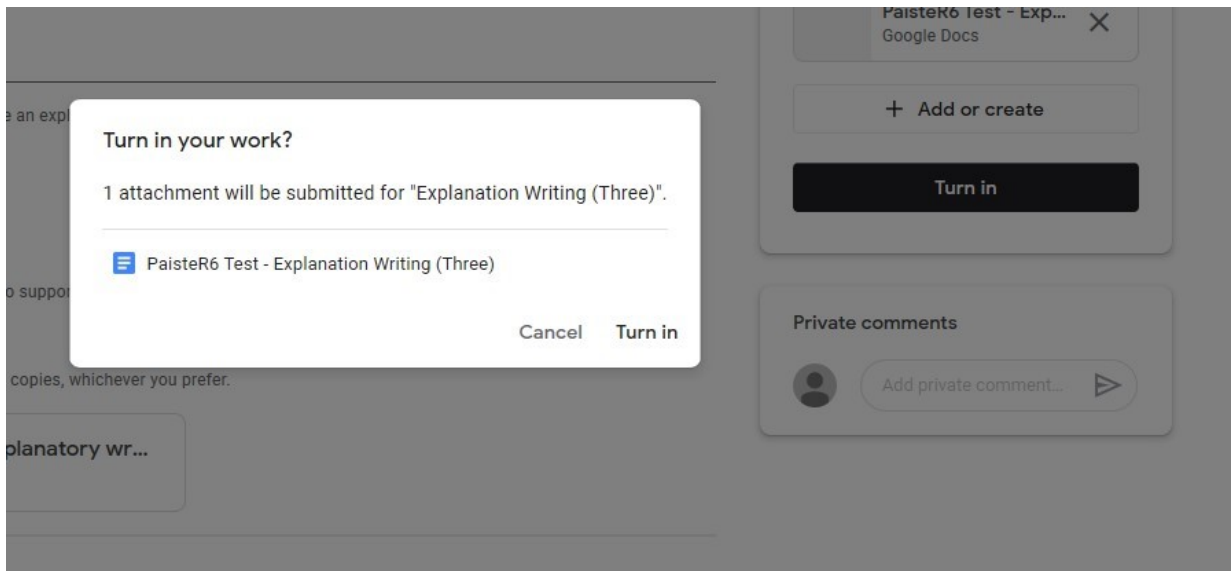
A doc was created for me (circle orange), so now I will click on this and type in my answer. (See below)

After I click Turn In I will be asked if I am sure. Which can be seen in the picture above.

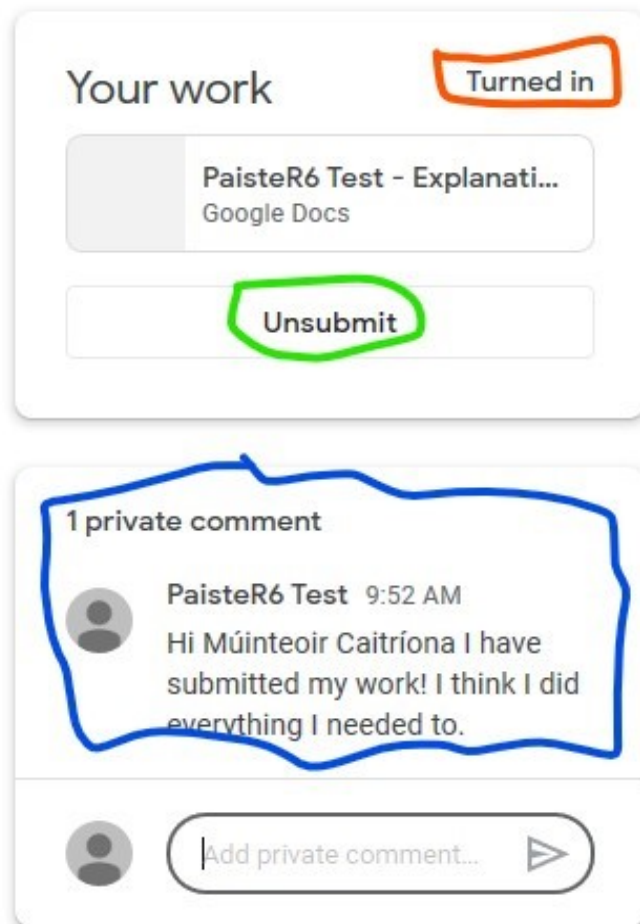
Click Turn In

To view any comments or corrections that my teacher makes on this work, I will come back here to see those.





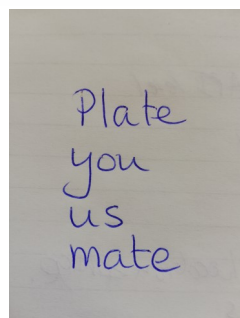

Again I log into my class. I go to classroom to see which tasks my teacher has set for me. Today I will do this Boggle task.

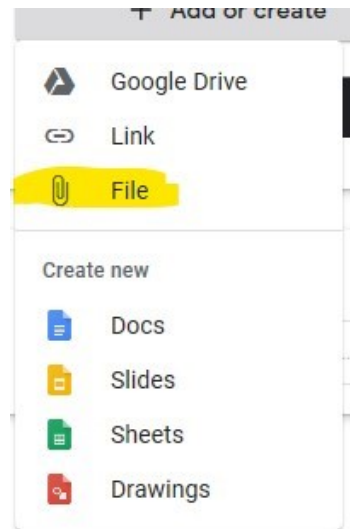
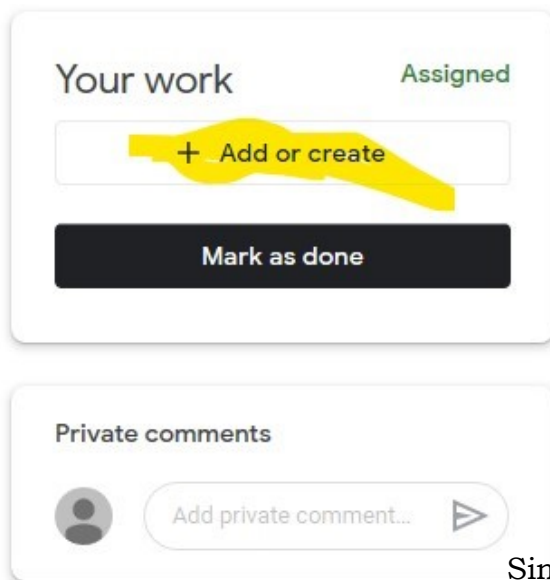
View Assignment

I will call it Boggle answer

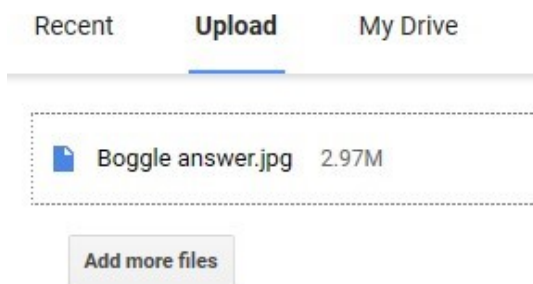


Similar to our last assignment. When I have a picture taken of my work. I go to +Add or Create (both images above)

Insert files using Google Drive

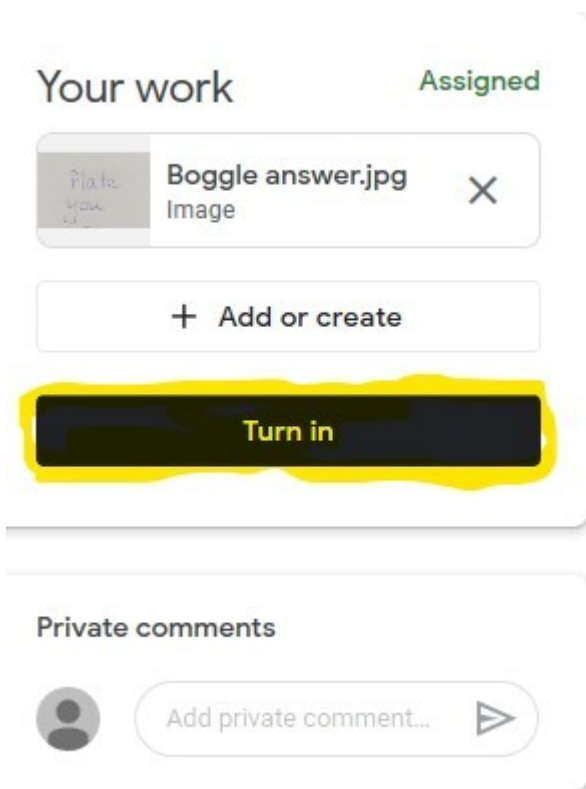
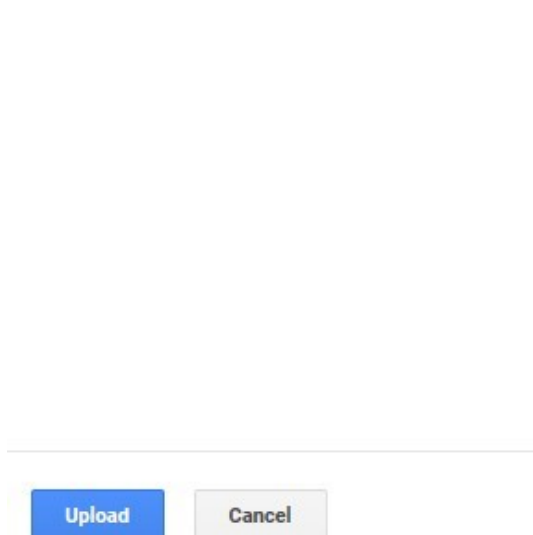
I click on File
